Midterm candidates for graduation shall be ranked with the graduating class.

To be ranked as one of the three top students of the graduation class, a student must have:

1. Met the number of credits classification standard;
2. Completed two years in a District high school;
3. Been enrolled the fall and spring semester of his or her senior year on the campus from which he or she graduates (exception: migrant students); and
4. Been enrolled four consecutive years in high school.

Ranking of Freshman, Sophomores, and Juniors

Freshmen, sophomores, and juniors shall be ranked at the end of the first semester for end-of-year recognition purposes.

Juniors shall be re-ranked after the end of the school year by computer services for the purpose of top ten percent eligibility for automatic college admission.

Freshmen, sophomores, and juniors shall have 15 days after the end of the first semester in which to clear INC/NCs for rank purposes.

Freshmen, sophomores, and juniors who transfer into a District high school campus from another District high school campus do so with the grade weights awarded by the sending campus at the time of withdrawal.

Credit awarded through credit by examination and credit for acceleration shall receive Level I rank unless the course is recognized as an advanced course as per TAC Chapter 74.

Details regarding credit by examination and credit for acceleration can be found in the high school course listing guide approved annually by the Board.

Administration is proposing that we waive policy for the 2019-2020 school year due to COVID19. Calculate grades up to the 4th six weeks and for Dual Credit students that we place their final grade as the 4th six weeks grade for adjunct professions from TSC or UTRGV.
