RE: Partial Closure of Campus at Rivera Early College High School

It has come to our attention that an employee of Rivera Early College High School recently tested positive for COVID-19. In an abundance of caution, we will only be closing the affected areas of the high school from **Thursday, July 9, 2020, through Monday, July 13, 2020**. The Brownsville Independent School District will take the opportunity to clean and disinfect the affected areas and ensure a safe environment at the school when it reopens on **Tuesday, July 14, 2020**.

The following are symptoms of COVID-19:

- 1.) Cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- 2.) Chills, repeated trembling with chills
- 3.) Headache, muscle pain, sore throat
- 4.) Red eyes
- 5.) Diarrhea
- 6.) Feeling feverish or a temperature measure greater than or equal to 100 degrees Fahrenheit

If you exhibit any of the above symptoms, do not report to work on **Tuesday, July 14, 2020**. Instead, seek medical attention and let your campus principal and human resources department know of your situation.

As stated, Rivera Early College High School will close the affected areas for the remaining week and employees will continue to work from home. If you cannot return on Tuesday, July 14, 2020, please contact your immediate supervisor to discuss alternative work options.
