




## Score Codes for Spring 2021 Reference Guide

<p><b>S</b></p> <p><b>Paper answer doc:</b> Enter S Score code</p> <p><b>Online Tester:</b> Code is automatically marked once the test is submitted for scoring by the student.</p>		<p><b>SCORE</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For all tests that will be scored.</li> <li>First-time EOC tester: Student is present and refuses to test.</li> <li>Student in grades 3-8 who is present and refuses to test</li> </ul>	A student completes the test on paper or online.
<p><b>O</b></p> <p><b>Paper answer doc:</b> Enter O Score code and mark 0 in column D</p> <p><b>Online Tester:</b> Enter O score code and enter 0 in column D in “Test Attributes”</p> 	<p><b>Mark 0 (zero) in Column D</b></p>	<p><b>OTHER- COVID Related</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Students who are remote learners and choose not come to test at school.</li> </ul>	The campus reaches out to a parent of a remote instruction student regarding testing. The parent communicates with the campus that the student will not be attending in-person testing in person.
<p><b>A</b></p> <p><b>Paper answer doc:</b> Enter A Score code</p> <p><b>Online Tester:</b> Enter A in “Test Attributes”</p> 		<p><b>ABSENT</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The student is Quarantined or is sick with COVID or other serious medical condition.</li> <li>Student is an in-person learner and is absent from testing (i.e. has the flu).</li> </ul>	<p><b>Scenario A:</b> The nurse notifies the campus of a student with a positive COVID result. The student remained at home during the testing.</p> <p><b>Scenario B:</b> Five students in one class are quarantined due to positive COVID exposure. The quarantine extends through the entire testing window.</p>
<p><b>O</b></p> <p><b>Paper answer doc:</b> Enter O Score code</p> <p><b>Online Tester:</b> Enter O ark in “Test Attributes”</p> 		<p><b>OTHER- Non-COVID Related</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>An EOC Retester who is present on a testing day and refuses to test.</li> <li>A student became ill during the test and was not able to finish.</li> <li>There was a testing irregularity (e.g., the student cheated on the test).</li> <li>A student who is court-ordered to participate in an authorized high school equivalency program (HSEP) qualifies to be and is excused from, taking the test according to 19 TAC §89.1409. Mark the “HSEP” bubble along with the “O” score code (EOC only).</li> </ul>
