Entries: Each school may make **FOUR** entries in each individual event. Only one relay per school per event. Each swimmer may swim up to two individual events and two relays or three relays and one individual event. Order of Events are The National Federation High School Championship, with the exception of diving.

Scoring: The top eight individual places will score. Relays will be worth double points. Top **SIX individuals and SIX relays** in the Varsity division will qualify from district to regional.

Awards: Medals for all top three finishes.

Entries due: All entries and diving sheets are due on **Sunday, January 23, 2022** by **5:00pm** to Monica Rosales. Please have your entries in Hy-Tek format and email the **entry file** and a **word document file** to Bisdaquatics@gmail.com. Psych sheets will be available to coaches only. All scratches are due on Saturday, the day of the meet or if by consensus of all the coaches, no scratches will be required.

Timers: Each school must provide TWO adult timers on Saturday, January 29, 2022.

TEAM SEATING: Teams will need to sit in their assigned areas throughout the meet unless they are competing.

SPECTATORS: AT THIS TIME spectators will be allowed to enter the facility. The bleachers must be used by the swim teams to be able to keep social distancing. The event will be live streamed on our web page.

Diving will be on Friday, January 28, 2021. Warm up will begin at 11:00am. The meet will start at 12:00pm. Depending on entries, this may be modified.

Swimming will be on Saturday, January 29, 2022. Warm up will begin at 10:00am. Assigned warm up lanes will be given. Coaches' meeting at 10:45am. The swim meet will start at 11:00am.

Covid-19 Care

Aquatic Center Facility Requirements

- Athletes and Coaches will come through the front door and will have their temperature checked. A temperature of 100 and above, the athlete will not be able to enter.
- Everyone must wear a mask. Athletes will take off their masks before entering the water and will put them back on once exiting the water.
- Teams must sit in their designated area. Social distance as much as possible.
- Coaches will be allowed on deck with social distancing. Your athlete will be allowed to stop and talk to you before or after their race and then must return to their team seating.
- One photographer will be allowed on the pool deck. Coaches must designate who their school photographer will be and they will need to wear an ID badge.
- Masks will be hung on the wall behind the starting block.
- Once the race is finished athletes will need to put their masks on and go to their designated area.
- One lap counter per 500 Free swimmer will be allowed.
- Locker rooms will be available for use. Two outside restrooms will be available as well
- Presentation of awards will be done at the center of the pool deck.
 Only the designated photographers or coaches will be allowed on the bulk head to take pictures.
- Modifications may need to be made at any time.
