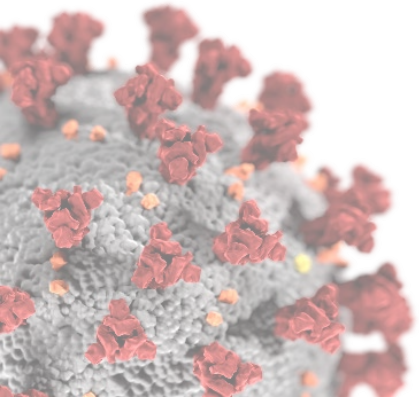


Positive Cases - STUDENTS



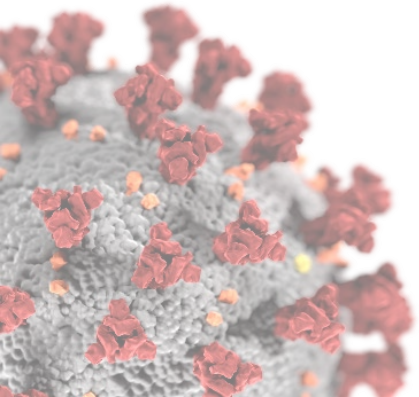
As more students get vaccinated, we have begun to see a decline in the number of positive COVID cases.

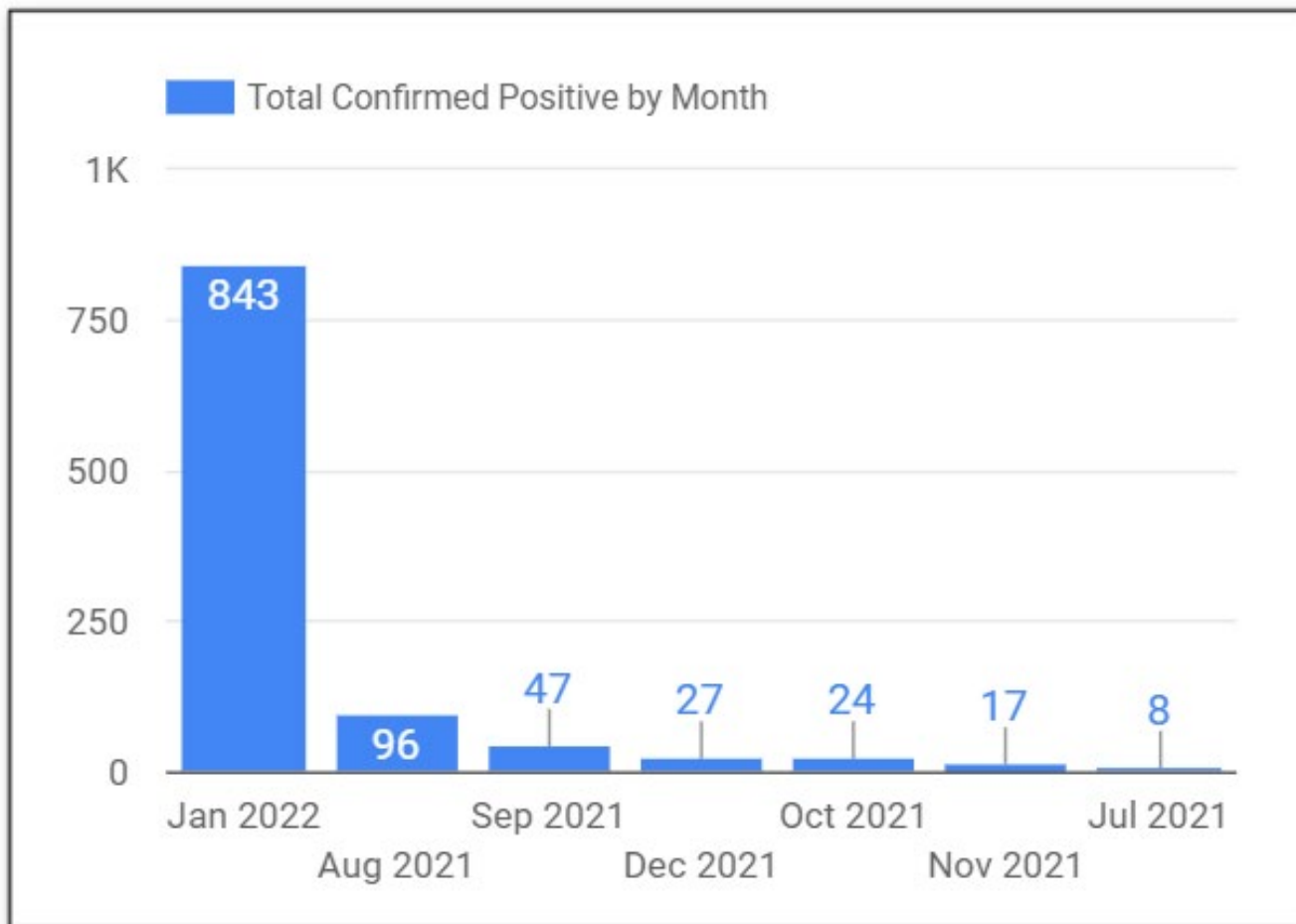


Positive Cases - STUDENTS

Jan. 10-14, 2022	1190	5	238	
Jan. 18-21, 2022	758	4	189.5	20%
Jan. 24-28, 2022	680	5	136	23%
Jan. 31- Feb 4, 2022	383	5	76.6	44%
Feb. 7 to present	88	3	29.3	77%

Acquisition of COVID Tests

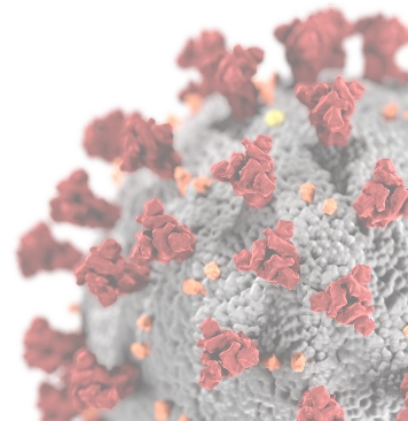
The Texas Education Agency continues to offer 7 vendors to select and purchase COVID tests with the funding provided.

In addition, BISD was selected as 1 of 5 districts in the State of Texas to receive COVID-19 tests. We received 10,240 tests last Friday, January 28, 2022.

At this time, BISD is fully stocked with a total of **41,800** COVID-19 tests.



Nurses, at ALL campuses, dedicate 1 hour per day to offer the COVID tests for students and staff. In addition, the staff may choose to get a COVID test at CAB.



Latest Updates on COVID Vaccines

BISD Health Services offers, 1st, 2nd, and Booster vaccines to students, staff and the community.

Individuals seeking a vaccine should call the Health Services office to schedule an appointment.




